



Clothing Guidelines

Introduction

Covenant Christian School desires to create a culture and atmosphere that encourages personal growth in Christian character and is conducive to learning. A factor that contributes to the culture and atmosphere of the school is student dress. The experience of numerous schools has confirmed that standardized student dress presents several significant advantages for school life. Examples of these advantages include reducing competition and peer fashion pressure, increasing mutual respect among students, and promoting school spirit.

To this end, the school has adopted clothing guidelines for students in Little Pelicans and Junior Pelicans and standardized dress for students in grades Kindergarten through sixth.

Please note that all items purchased in the past with the Covenant School logo are “grandfathered in.” Therefore, you are welcome to send your student to school wearing these items.

Spirit Days

The school administration, on occasion, will designate certain days as Spirit Days and allow for exceptions to these clothing guidelines.

Guidelines for All Students

The following general clothing guidelines must be adhered to:

- All clothing should be in good repair (no frayed material).
- All shirts with tails must be tucked in.
- Girls wearing skirts or jumpers are to wear modesty shorts underneath.
- Shorts must be no more than 6” from the floor when the student is kneeling upright.
- Students must wear shoes or sandals with backs (no flip flops or beach sandals).
- Socks must be of solid color, white, black or blue.
- Hats are not to be worn inside the school.
- Visible temporary tattoos are not to be worn by children in grades 1 through 6.
- Body piercings are not permitted.
- Earrings are not allowed for boys.
- For girls, skirts, skorts, and jumpers are no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- Hair should be neat and clean. Boys’ hair should be moderate in length and should not be longer than the shirt collar. Hair should not extend beyond the eyebrows in the front. Unusual hairstyles, which call attention to the individual, will not be permitted. All hair must be of natural color for both boys and girls.

Guidelines for Little Pelicans and Junior Pelicans Students

Everyday Attire

The primary emphasis of the preschool wardrobe should be clothing that is neat, modest, in good repair, and appropriate for the weather.

Field Trip Attire

All Junior Pelicans students must purchase from Lands' End a red polo shirt embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo for field trips.

Girls Standardized Dress Grades Kindergarten through Sixth

Everyday Standardized Dress Attire

All students must wear shirts purchased through Lands' End embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo. For bottoms, the school has specified "standardized dress" style bottoms in navy blue while allowing the purchase of these items from any provider except for athletic style shorts, which must be purchased through Lands' End. Please note that bottoms must be "standardized dress" style.

Only school sweaters, sweater vests, fleeces, or sweatshirts with the school logo may be worn in the classroom over shirts. Plain white t-shirts only may be worn under collared shirts. Athletic wear (i.e., Under Armour) should not be worn under school standardized dress.

Shirts

- Mesh Polo: May be short or long-sleeve in red, white, or gray (also feminine fit).
- Interlock Polo: May be short or long sleeve in red, white, or gray (also feminine fit).
- Knit Peter Pan Polo: May be short or long sleeve in white.
- Tee Shirt: May be short or long-sleeve in red.
- Crew Sweatshirt: May be red or gray heather.
- Drifter Sweaters: May be crew or V-neck in red or white or vest in red.
- Cotton Cardigan: May be red or white.
- Fleece: May be a jacket, half-zip, or vest in red or navy.
- Oxford: May be short or long-sleeve in white.

Bottoms

All bottoms must be standardized dress navy twill with exceptions noted below.

- Pants
- Pleated skirt (navy or Lands' End classic navy large plaid)
- Skorts (navy or Lands' End classic navy large plaid)
- Shorts
- Capris
- Navy leggings only under skirts and jumpers (these may not be worn on their own)

Dresses and Jumpers

- Jumper: May be in navy or Lands' End classic navy large plaid.
- Mesh Polo Dress: May be short or long sleeve in red or navy.
- Knit Ruffle Front Dress: May be short or long sleeve in red or navy.

Field Trip Standardized Dress Attire

All girls in Kindergarten through Sixth Grade must purchase a red polo shirt embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo for field trips and special events.

Formal Standardized Dress Attire

All girls in Kindergarten through Sixth Grade must purchase a plaid skirt/jumper with a white collared shirt for special chapels, public performances, and school “ambassador” opportunities. The shirt should be logoed if you choose to wear a skirt. If the weather is cold, tights or leggings must be navy. Shoes should blend in with the standardized dress and not draw attention.

Boys Standardized Dress Grades Kindergarten through Sixth

Everyday Standardized Dress Attire

All students must wear shirts purchased through Lands’ End embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo. For bottoms, the school has specified “standardized dress” style bottoms in navy while allowing the purchase of these items from any standardized dress supply provider, except for athletic style shorts, which must be purchased through Lands’ End. Please note that bottoms must be “standardized dress” style.

Only school sweaters, sweater vests, fleeces, or sweatshirts with the school logo may be worn in the classroom over collared shirts. White t-shirts only may be worn under collared shirts.

Athletic wear (i.e., Under Armour) is not to be worn under school standardized dress.

Shirts

- Mesh Polo: May be short or long sleeve in red, white, or gray
- Interlock Polo: May be short or long sleeve in red, white, or gray
- Tee Shirt: May be short or long-sleeve in red.
- Crew Sweatshirt: May be red or gray heather.
- Drifter Sweaters: May be crew or V-neck in red or white or vest in red.
- Fleece: May be a jacket, half-zip, or vest in red.
- Oxford: May be short or long-sleeve in white.

Ties

Each student must have a classic navy large plaid tie purchased through Lands’ End.

Bottoms

All bottoms must be standardized dress style navy. Boys may wear pants or shorts. No cargo “style” pants are permitted.

Field Trips Standardized Dress Attire

All boys in Kindergarten through Sixth Grade must purchase a red polo shirt embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo for field trips and special events.

Formal Standardized Dress Attire

All boys in Kindergarten through Sixth Grade must purchase a plaid tie and a white oxford for special chapels, public performances, and school “ambassador” opportunities. Long pants and a belt are required. (During warm weather, chino navy shorts with a belt are permitted.) Shoes should blend in with the standardized dress and not draw attention.

Ordering Information

All standardized dress shirts must be purchased through Lands’ End. Standardized dress bottoms may be purchased through any standardized dress provider.
